## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Moving to Higher Ground 2010 will be the Fraser Valley Child Development Centre's 8th unique mentorship learning experience for paediatric therapists, combining professional development with personal growth. Individualized learning programs are planned prior to the workshop through discussion between therapist participants and co-coordinator Kim Barthel. Therapists will be paired with children in a hands on experience who match the areas in which the therapists wish to gain expertise and confidence. In addition to hands on practice, therapists will be supported by demonstrations, lectures and group discussions.
